<p><b>I. IDENTIFICATION</b> (held on a date prior to the date of rabies vaccination)</p>	- Microchip
<p><b>II. VALID RABIES VACCINATION</b> (dogs e cats)</p>	- Valid Rabies Vaccination (applied for at least 120 days and not more than 365 days before the date of importation into Iceland).
<p><b>III. OTHER VACCINATIONS</b> With regard to dogs</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Vaccine against <b>Leptospirosis</b> (applied at least 30 days and not more than 180 days before the date of import into Iceland).</li> <li>- Vaccine against <b>Canine Distemper</b> (applied for at least 30 days and not more than 730 days before the date of import into Iceland).</li> <li>- Vaccine against <b>contagious Hepatitis</b> (applied for at least 30 days and not more than 365 days before the date of import into Iceland).</li> <li>- Vaccine against <b>Parvovirosis</b> (applied for at least 30 days and not more than 365 days before the date of import into Iceland).</li> </ul>
<p><b>IV. OTHER VACCINATIONS</b> With regard to cats</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Vaccine against <b>Feline Panleucopenia</b> (applied for at least 30 days and not more than 365 days before the date of import into Iceland).</li> <li>- Vaccine against <b>Feline Rhinotracheitis</b> (applied for at least 30 days and not more than 365 days before the date of import into Iceland).</li> <li>- Vaccine against <b>Calcivirus</b> (applied for at least 30 days and not more than 365 days before the date of import into Iceland).</li> </ul>
<p><b>V. MINIMUM AGE OF ANIMALS ENTRY IN ICELAND, from Portugal</b></p>	- 7 Months
<p><b>VI. TREATMENTS</b></p>	<p><b>AGAINST ECHINOCOCCOSIS, (<i>Echinococcus multilocularis</i> and <i>Echinococcus granulosus</i>):</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Dogs and Cats subject to treatment with an approved product containing the praziquantel active principle, carried out during the 10-day period prior to import.</li> </ul> <p><b>AGAINST EXTERNAL PARASITES:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Dogs and cats subject to treatment with an approved product containing the fipronil or permethrin active principles: permethrin - in the case of dogs, and fipronil - in the case of cats, carried out during the 10-day period prior to import.</li> </ul>

	<p><b>AGAINST EAR MITE INFECTION:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Treatment with an approved product, whose name must appear on the certificate.</li> </ul>
<p><b>VII. LABORATORY TESTS</b></p>	<p><b>RABBIES (dogs and cats)</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- The anti-rabies antibody titration test should be performed on a blood sample collected 30-365 days after the date of the rabies vaccination (at least 30 days after the vaccination date and no later than 365 days after the vaccination date). The level of antibodies should be at least 0.5 IU/ ml.</li> </ul>
	<p><b>BRUCELOSIS (dogs)</b></p> <p>Blood sample – carried out within 30 days prior to import, with a negative result.</p> <p><b>SALMONELOSIS (dogs)</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- stool sample - carried out in the period of 30 days prior to import, with negative result; otherwise a risk analysis should be carried out by the MAST * (official authorities in Iceland).</li> </ul>
	<p><b>FIV (cats)</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- blood sample – carried out in the period of 30 days prior to import, with negative result.</li> </ul> <p><b>FeLV (cats)</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- blood sample – carried out in the period of 30 days prior to import, with negative result.</li> </ul> <p><b>SALMONELOSIS (cats)</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- stool sample – carried out in the period of 30 days prior to import, with negative result; otherwise a risk analysis should be carried out by the MAST *.</li> </ul>
<p><b>VIII. DOCUMENTS</b></p>	<p>1 - <a href="#">IMPORT PERMIT FOR A DOG</a> – whose model, filled in, the Owner/Importer of the dog sends to the MAST * (validity of the license is 1 year).</p> <p>1 - <a href="#">IMPORT PERMIT FOR A CAT</a> - whose model, filled in, the Owner/Importer of the dog sends to the MAST * (validity of the license is 1 year).</p> <p><b>2 - <a href="#">CERTIFICATE OF HEALTH AND ORIGIN FOR IMPORT OF A DOG TO ICELAND</a></b> – issued by the clinical veterinarian of the animal's country of origin within a period of 10 days prior to import, in a specific model, whose copy must be sent to the MAST, at least 5 working days before the date of import, by:  Fax: +354 530 4801/mail: <a href="mailto:mast@mast.is">mast@mast.is</a>.  Fully completed certificate, with clear flight information. It is mandatory to mention a correct phone number and email on the certificate.</p> <p><b>2 - <a href="#">CERTIFICATE OF HEALTH AND ORIGIN FOR IMPORT OF A CAT TO ICELAND</a></b> – issued by the veterinarian of the country of origin</p>

	<p>of the animal within 10 days prior to import, in a specific model, whose copy must be sent to MAST at least 5 working days before the date of import.:</p> <p>fax: +354 530 4801/mail: <a href="mailto:mast@mast.is">mast@mast.is</a></p> <p>Fully completed certificate, with clear flight information. It is mandatory to mention a correct phone number and email in the certificate.</p>
<b>IX. ANIMAL TRANSPORT BOX</b>	<p>The transport box must be large enough to allow the animal to stand, lie down and turn around. It should be made of material that is easy to clean and disinfect and should not be made of wood. Non-rigid carrying cases are not accepted.</p>
<b>X. QUARENTINE</b>	<p>Quarantine period of 4 weeks. Booking and information at: <a href="http://www.einangrun.is/">http://www.einangrun.is/</a> or <a href="http://www.kelahus.is">www.kelahus.is</a></p> <p>Reservation in the quarantine establishment is needed in advance.</p>
<b>XI. FLIGHT RESERVATION</b>	<p>- The only airport approved for the entry of dogs and cats in Iceland is Keflavik airport.</p> <p>If the animals arrive at the airport after office hours, they will remain in temporary facilities at the airport until they can be examined by the veterinarian the next day, and that is the reason why it is advisable to introduce the animals into the country during office hours.</p>
<b>XII. ON BORDER CONTROL</b>	<p>- - Animals to be imported and their original documentation (IMPORT PERMIT, CERTIFICATE OF HEALTH AND ORIGIN e ORIGINAL SEROLOGICAL RABIES REPORT) Must be submitted to Customs <a href="mailto:upplysingar@tollur.is">upplysingar@tollur.is</a> upon arrival in Iceland. The original documents must be contained in a waterproof package securely attached to the transport box of the animal.</p> <p>- Customs Fee - Animals purchased in the last 12 months - for more information - Directorate of Customs <a href="mailto:upplysingar@tollur.is">upplysingar@tollur.is</a> or +354 569 1750</p>
